

# CANO

*History:* Cano is a Turkish dance from the former Yugoslavia. This is a simple line dance for women. Cano is the name of a girl. Ercument learned the dance in 1988 from Necmettin Okur in Austin, TX.

*Pronounced:* JANO

*Meter:* 2/4

*Formation:* Hand hold in "W" position, line or circle, moving in LOD (happy and bouncy)

## Measures

### FIG.1

- 1 Facing center touch R toe in front, arms FWD (count 1, &)  
Touch R toe beside L (count 2, &)
- 2 REPEAT measure 1
- 3 With bouncy arms, step R into center (count 1), step L beside R (count &)  
Step R into center (count 2, &)
- 4 With bouncy arms REPEAT measures 3 w/opposite footwork
- 5 Cross R in front of L and touch w/toe, moving arms to L (count 1, &)  
Open to R and touch R, arms to R (count 2, &)
- 6 REPEAT measure 5
- 7-8 REPEAT measures 3-4, moving away from center w/bouncy arms

### FIG. 2

- 9 Step R in LOD (count 1, &)  
Step L in LOD (count 2, &)
- 10-11 REPEAT measure 9 twice
- 12 Step R in place (count 1), step L beside (count &)  
Step R in place (count 2, &)
- 13-15 REPEAT measures 9-11 w/opposite footwork, facing center
- 17-32 REPEAT FIG 1 two times
- 33-40 REPEAT FIG. 2
- 41-48 REPEAT FIG. 1
- 49-64 16 step-together-steps in LOD, bouncy arms
- 65-72 REPEAT FIG. 2
- 73-88 REPEAT FIG. 1 twice
